

Export & ITAR Control Compliance Procedures

Griffiths Aero Ltd. T/A Marilake Aero Systems understands the importance of export compliance and takes its responsibilities seriously.

Export & ITAR Control regulations are enforced in countries throughout the world to support national security policies and prevent the illegitimate development and use of Weapons and related terrorist activities. Over the past few years the political and economic climate has sharpened the focus on export controls and as a consequence regulations are tightening and enforcement is increasing.

Only a very small proportion of Marilake Aero Systems' capability may be subject to Export or ITAR controls and the company's contract review process is activated on a "point of entry basis" to ensure compliance with all current regulations.

Marilake Aerosystems screens all new and existing customers and suppliers to ensure business is not done with prohibited entities or products.

Should a customer or product be flagged as Export or ITAR controlled under the company's internal contract review process, Marilake Aerosystems will ensure all the necessary licenses and other government approvals are in place prior to exporting control listed products. The information will be stored against the product file for reference.

The purpose of these controls is to limit the supply of the technology or strategic goods to countries proscribed, principally for reasons of proliferation, security, or terrorism.
